# **DIOCESE OF EAST CAROLINA 2025 Proposed Budget**

#### INCOME

- The recommended 2025 budget includes \$15,966 from surplus reserves to balance the budget. Parishes will be requested to Pledge at 10% of their Operating Income from 2023 Parochial Report.
- Allocating prior year pledge income for 2024 at \$ 30,000.00.
- Allocating a draw from the Foreman Fund Income \$25,000
- Foundation support for 2025 will be 4%

# **EXPENSES**

The 2025 budget includes adjustments to salaries of 2.57% COLA. There is also increased cost in health insurance costs in 2025

#### OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

- <u>The Office of the Episcopate Personnel Expense</u> includes three positions, the Bishop, Bishop Administrator and Communications Coordinator
- This section funds the general functions and operations of the bishop's office including travel, communications, Seminarians, Chancellor, Standing Committee, Executive Council, Clergy Conference, Commission on Ministry and Diocesan Convention.

#### Of Note for 2025

- 1-5501-00- Reduced Convention Registration Fee for Fall 2025
- 1-5506-00- General Convention will not meet until 2027 but we accrue one-third expenses over the three-year period to cover the cost Acct 1-5506-01.

#### RESOURCES AND ADMINISTRATION

- The Office of Administration Personnel Expense includes three positions, the Director of Finance and Administration, Administrative Assistant/Bookkeeper, Data Management/Office Assistant.
- This section funds the operations of Diocesan House, Diocesan Staff and administrative resources and support for parishes in the diocese.

# **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT**

- <u>Leadership and Development Personnel Expense</u> includes five positions, Canon for Leadership Development, Spanish Missioner, Coordinator of Small Church Ministry, Missioner for People of African Descent, Missioner for lifelong Christian Education. These positions are in response to our Diocesan Mission Priorities.
- This section funds the work and ministry of the Canon of Leadership Development, Spanish Ministry, Ministry for People of African Descent, Small Church Ministry and Lifelong Christian Formation for Youth /Campus Ministry.
