RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MISSION PRIORITIES FOR THE DIOCESE OF EAST CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the Executive Council and Finance Committees of the Diocese expressed a desire for Mission Priorities to shape decision making and best use the resources God has given to us, leading to a discernment process on how we the Diocese of East Carolina feel called by God at this time;

WHEREAS, the discernment process launched with *Journey Through East Carolina* in November 2020, was followed by a time of study and prayer in the Easter season of 2021 that invited input regarding Mission Priorities from across the Diocese, and culminated in an Executive Council Retreat in June 2021, at which that abundant input was considered and prioritized;

WHEREAS, the first draft of proposed Mission Priorities was reviewed by the Executive Council and then the clergy of the Diocese in October 2021, the drafted Mission Priorities were then shared with the whole of the Diocese for additional reflection and feedback distilled into a final draft of proposed Mission Priorities, and this final draft was assessed at the Executive Council retreat in March 2022, after the rescheduling of the 139th Convention to June 2022.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the people of the Diocese of East Carolina, gathered in Convention, adopt the attached expression of our Mission Priorities as a living document, open to reassessment and revision in new times of calling, to aid in the work of ministry and resource allocation.
